Purpose

1. To conduct fair and effective hearings and make determinations on the Council's regulatory functions under legislation and other matters as referred to the Committee.

2. To recommend to the Council or relevant Council committee any matters that it considers necessary to enable the effective management of the Council's regulatory functions.

Terms of Reference:

- 1. Hear and determine any statutory or regulatory hearings under relevant legislation unless otherwise delegated or retained by the Council, including (but without limitation):
 - a. objections under the Dog Control Act 1996;
 - b. matters under the Resource Management Act 1991 and related legislation;
 - c. matters under the Impounding Act 1955;
 - d. matters regarding drainage and works on private land under the Local Government Act 1974 and Local Government Act 2002;
 - e. matters under the Gambling Act 2003, Health Act 1956 and Litter Act 1979;
 - f. matters regarding residential pools under the Building Act 2004.
- 2. Hear and determine other matters that require hearings or submissions, as referred by Council or other Committees.
- 3. To convene working groups and carry out the Terms of Reference approved and referred by Council or other Committees.

The Subcommittee is delegated the following powers to act:

- Conduct statutory hearings on regulatory matters and undertake and make decisions on those hearings that fall within the committee's Terms of Reference.
- Appoint additional members, including external members, for hearings where expert advice is required.
- Establish and amend hearings protocols relating to the general conduct of hearings and hearings- related matters in accordance with the applicable legislation and the principles of administrative law and natural justice.
- Approval of activities and expenses relating to working groups consistent with the terms of reference and approved working group budget.

Explanatory Note:

- 1. The Committee may request expert advice through the Chief Executive when necessary.
- 2. The General Manager Customer Support, in consultation with the Chairperson of the Regulatory Subcommittee, are delegated the power to determine:
 - a. the composition of any hearings panel to be convened under the committee's terms of reference; and
 - b. the appointment of any independent hearings commissioner within the panel of commissioners approved by the Council, to hear and determine any matter under the Resource Management Act 1991 (and related legislation). An independent commissioner can be appointed to act in his/her sole capacity, or together with appointed councillors who hold the appropriate accreditation.
- **3.** Decisions of a hearing panel shall be made by consensus although if necessary the majority view prevails

Purpose of the report Te Take moo te puurongo

To provide information to the Policy and Regulatory Subcommittee ("the Committee") to enable the Committee to hear the objection to a Menacing Classification imposed on the dog ("Sarge") belonging to Craig Isherwood ("Mr Isherwood").

2. Executive summary Whakaraapopototanga matua

Section 33A of the Dog Control Act 1996 ("the Act") allows Waikato District Council ("Council") to classify a dog as menacing if the dog is considered to pose a threat to a person or other animal due to observed or reported behaviour (Sections 33A and Section 33B of the Act annexed as Appendix 1).

Sarge, a black male Huntaway cross Border Collie, aged 1 year 10 months and owned by Mr Isherwood was observed chasing sheep and, a short time later that same day, was observed attacking a Border Collie. The attack occurred in the public reserve across the road from Mr Isherwood's partially fenced address at 58 Alexandra Redoubt Road, Tuakau. As a response to the attack Animal Control Officer Amanda Twiss ("ACO Twiss") attended the property.

After investigation, Council advised Mr Isherwood of the decision to classify Sarge as Menacing (Notice of Classification of dog as Menacing annexed as Appendix 2).

In accordance with section 33B of the Act, Mr Isherwood's partner, Nicola Brookes ("Miss Brookes"), who is claiming ownership of Sarge, formally objected in writing to the menacing classification within the statutory time frame (Email Notification of Objection to Menacing Classification and Acknowledgement annexed as Appendix 3).

There are no records held with Council confirming Miss Brookes claim of ownership of Sarge. Council's Register of Ownership for Sarge names Mr Isherwood as being Sarge's

owner (P&R Registration Record for Mr Isherwood annexed at Appendix 4) (P&R Registration Record for Sarge annexed at Appendix 5)

Council considers that Sarge poses an ongoing threat to persons or animals given the circumstances of the reported incidents and Sarge's history of roaming.

Council understands that although Miss Brookes has claimed in her emailed objection, they are erecting a kennel and large run for Sarge, Council submits that for public safety reasons Sarge should remain classified as menacing, requiring Sarge to be muzzled when in public.

3. Staff recommendations

Tuutohu-aa-kaimahi

THAT the Policy and Regulatory Subcommittee

- a. receives the report; and
- b. the Classification of Sarge under section 33(A)(2) of the Dog Control Act 1996 be upheld.

4. Background Koorero whaimaarama

On 24 November 2023 at 10:52 hours, Council's call centre received a complaint from a member of the public, Ms Antonella Hagspihl ("Ms Hagspihl") had observed a black dog chasing sheep and that the dog had then gone onto the reserve next to the Pony Club and attacked another dog (Service Request annexed as Appendix 6).

Ms Hagspihl describes in her Statement (Complainant Statement annexed as Appendix 7) that on Thursday 23 November 2023 at approximately 5:30pm, she had gone to the Pony club on Alexandra Redoubt Road, Tuakau for a horse lesson.

At approximately 6:30pm, she had gone to the paddock beside the Pony Club and where there were sheep grazing. Whilst there, she observed a dog she described as a black Pitbull, known to her from previous experience, resides at the first house on the right-hand side of Alexandra Redoubt Road, later confirmed as 58 Alexandra Redoubt Road, coming from the direction of River Road, Tuakau chasing and barking at the sheep.

Ms Hagspihl stated that she had rushed towards the dog, yelling at it. The dog had turned around and started heading towards the reserve beside the Pony Club. Ms Hagspihl had continued her lesson but had kept an eye on the dog as she was concerned it would come back.

A short while later, Ms Hagspihl had heard growling, barking, and screaming coming from the reserve. She had looked across and could see the same dog attacking a Border Collie which was being walked by a man.

Ms Hagspihl stated that she saw the black dog had pinned the Border Collie to the ground. She also saw another Border Collie standing nearby. She stated that she saw the man with the Collie kick the black dog and it had let go of the Collie.

The black dog had stood there for a while then had rushed and attacked the collie again. The man had kicked and screamed at the dog again and it had let go of the Collie and ran off South towards the other end of the Pony Club. The black dog had disappeared for approximately 30 minutes then Ms Hagspihl had observed it heading in the direction of its home. Ms Hagspihl stated that this is not the first time she has seen the dog out, and she stated that she has previously seen the same dog in with the sheep before.

ACO Twiss, states in her Statement (ACO statement annexed as Appendix 8) that she received a Historic Aggressive Complaint about a dog sighted chasing sheep.

As noted in the onsite time in the Service Request, at 11:24 hours ACO Twiss attended the location of the report after having spoken to Ms Hagspihl over the phone. It was during this conversation, Ms Hagspihl described where she believed the dog lived, and was later confirmed to be 58 Alexandra Redoubt Road, Tuakau.

Ms Hagspihl further relayed during that conversation, that it was not the first time she had sighted the same dog wandering, and she was prepared to give a statement.

ACO Twiss recorded Ms Hagspihl's statement over the phone.

ACO Twiss attempted to call Mr Isherwood but was only able to leave a voice message explaining what had happened.

On 28 November 2023 at 2:04pm, ACO Twiss, accompanied by ACO Joanne Smout, visited 58 Alexander Redoubt Road, Tuakau and spoke to Mr Isherwood about the two incidents involving Sarge. Mr Isherwood told ACO Twiss that he didn't believe either incident had occurred.

ACO Twiss advised Mr Isherwood that there were ongoing concerns that Sarge's behaviour was escalating, and due to Sarge's extensive history with Council (Waikato District Council P&R Reports and Impounds annexed as Appendix 9),

Council were classifying Sarge as Menacing as well as issuing an infringement. ACO Twiss asked Mr Isherwood how he was attempting to keep Sarge contained within the property and he showed her a running wire.

ACO Twiss notes in the Classification Decision Making Criteria (Decision making criteria annexed as Appendix 10) that the Property is not fenced sufficiently to contain Sarge, with large gaps where there is no fencing allowing Sarge to freely leave the property. She notes that there used to be fencing along the garage to keep Sarge penned but part of that had been removed.

Ms Brookes noted in her Notice of Objection email that a kennel and run is being erected to contain Sarge.

ACO Twiss discussed with Senior Animal Control Officer Amanda Davis ("SACO Davis") the incidents and reasoning for issuing Mr Isherwood with the Menacing Classification and on 7 December 2023, ACO Twiss hand delivered the Notice of Classification of Dog as Menacing Dog and was signed for by Mr Isherwood.

On 20 December 2023, Ms Brookes emailed SACO Davis stating that she had changed the ownership of Sarge to herself and that she was objecting to the Menacing Classification (" Ms Brookes' email titled Objection to the Menacing Classification annexed at Appendix 3")

On 21 December 2023, Ms Brookes was emailed Acknowledgement of her Objection to the Menacing Classification ("Ms Brookes' email titled Objection to the Menacing Classification and reply to her Objection annexed at Appendix 3").

Having received Ms Brookes objection to the menacing classification, the objection now needs to be determined in accordance with section 33B of the Act (sections 33A and 33B of the Act annexed as Appendix 1).

On Monday 29 January 2024, Council was sent an email containing photographs and video of Sarge chasing sheep in the paddock beside the Tuakau Pony Club (Email received showing video and photos of sarge annexed at Appendix 11).

The photos show a person holding Sarge's collar and registration tag (Photos of Sarge Roaming annexed as Appendix 12) and the video shows Sarge in a paddock chasing sheep (Video of Sarge Chasing Sheep annexed as Appendix 13).

On Tuesday 30 January 2024, ACO Kerwyn Wyatt went to 58 Alexandra Redoubt Road and seized Sarge for breach of Section 33E(1)(a) of the Dog Control Act 1996 (Notice of Seizure annexed at Appendix 14)(S33E Effect of Classification as Menacing Dog annexed as Appendix 15). Sarge was taken to the Pukekohe Dog Pound and impounded (Gate Impound Form annexed at Appendix 16).

On Wednesday 31 January 2024, a Notice of Retention Letter (Notice of Retention Letter annexed as Appendix 17) was hand delivered to 58 Alexandra Redoubt Road, Tuakau. This letter explained that Council was retaining Sarge until Mr Isherwood can demonstrate comprehensively how he intends to contain Sarge on his property.

Discussion and analysisTaataritanga me ngaa tohutohu

Section 33B(2) of the Act (Appendix 1) provides that in determining this objection the Committee shall have regard to:

- (a) the evidence which formed the basis for the classification; and
- (b) any steps taken by the owner to prevent any threat to the safety of persons or animals; and
- (c) the matters relied on in support of the objection; and
- (d) any other relevant matters.

As a result of this analysis, the Committee will have the following options:

- A. Uphold the classification of Sarge as menacing; or
- B. Rescind the classification.

The Committee must give written notice of its decision and the reasons for it, under section 33B(3) of the Act to the objector.

The option preferred by staff is option A, and the reasons for this recommendation are discussed below.

5.1 Options

Ngaa koowhiringa

Staff recommend option A because:

- The Act states that the territorial authority may classify a dog as menacing if the territorial authority considers Sarge may pose a threat to any person, stock, poultry, domestic animal, or protected wildlife because of any observed or reported behaviour of Sarge.
- Sarge was free to leave the Property and able to access a public place and exhibited behaviour which indicates he may pose a threat to any person or domestic pet. As a result of being able to leave the Property, Sarge made contact with another dog, injuring it.
- The owner was not present at the time of the incident and no one else was in attendance to control Sarge physically or verbally to prevent this situation occurring.
- A menacing classification ensures that:
 - o Sarge is muzzled when in public to help mitigate the threat Sarge poses.
 - o If Sarge offends again, a menacing classification allows Animal Control to take stronger measures of enforcement such as seizure of Sarge until Mr Isherwood can demonstrate how he is going to prevent further offending.
 - Mr Isherwood takes the appropriate steps to ensure any threatening behaviour is mitigated.

5.2 Financial considerations

Whaiwhakaaro puutea

There are no material financial considerations associated with the recommendations of this report.

5.3 Legal considerations

Whaiwhakaaro-aa-ture

Staff confirm that the staff recommendation complies with the Council's legal and policy requirements. Legal Counsel will be available to assist the Committee with the matters of law as required.

5.4 Strategy and policy considerations

Whaiwhakaaro whakamaaherehere kaupapa here

The report and recommendations are consistent with the Council's policies, plans and prior decisions.

5.5 Maaori and cultural considerations

Whaiwhakaaro Maaori me oona tikanga

There are no wider Maaori, or cultural considerations involved in the exercise of Council's legislative responsibilities under the Act.

5.6 Climate response and resilience considerations

Whaiwhakaaro-aa-taiao

The matters in this report have no known impact on climate change or resilience for the Council.

5.7 Risks

Tuuraru

Should the Committee uphold the classification and proceed with the staff recommendation, the classification stands with no further recourse for appeal by the objector.

Should the Committee rescind the classification, there is a risk that further breaches of the Act will occur, and members of the public could be further threatened or even harmed.

6. Significance and engagement assessment Aromatawai paahekoheko

6.1 Significance

The decisions and matters of this report are assessed as of low significance, in accordance with the Council's <u>Significance and Engagement Policy</u>.

6.2 Engagement

Te Whakatuutakitaki

This is a regulatory/operational matter concerning an individual and we do not propose to inform more broadly than necessary to give effect to the classification, if upheld.

7. Next steps Ahu whakamua

Should the classification be upheld, it will apply at a national level.

Council's role will be to update the relevant records and enforce the requirements of the classification.

Menacing dogs

Heading: inserted, on 1 December 2003, by section 21 of the Dog Control Amendment Act 2003 (2003 No 119).

33A Territorial authority may classify dog as menacing

- (1) This section applies to a dog that-
 - (a) has not been classified as a dangerous dog under section 31; but
 - (b) a territorial authority considers may pose a threat to any person, stock, poultry, domestic animal, or protected wildlife because of—
 - (i) any observed or reported behaviour of the dog; or
 - any characteristics typically associated with the dog's breed or type.
- (2) A territorial authority may, for the purposes of section 33E(1)(a), classify a dog to which this section applies as a menacing dog.
- (3) If a dog is classified as a menacing dog under subsection (2), the territorial authority must immediately give written notice in the prescribed form to the owner of—
 - (a) the classification; and
 - (b) the provisions of section 33E (which relates to the effect of classification as a menacing dog); and
 - (c) the right to object to the classification under section 33B; and
 - (d) if the territorial authority's policy is not to require the neutering of menacing dogs (or would not require the neutering of the dog concerned), the effect of sections 33EA and 33EB if the owner does not object to the classification and the dog is moved to the district of another territorial authority.

Section 33A: inserted, on 1 December 2003, by section 21 of the Dog Control Amendment Act 2003 (2003 No 119).

Section 33A(3): amended, on 1 November 2004, by section 10 of the Dog Control Amendment Act 2004 (2004 No 61).

Section 33A(3)(c): amended, on 28 June 2006, by section 13 of the Dog Control Amendment Act 2006 (2006 No 23).

Section 33A(3)(d): added, on 28 June 2006, by section 13 of the Dog Control Amendment Act 2006 (2006 No 23).

33B Objection to classification of dog under section 33A

- (1) If a dog is classified under section 33A as a menacing dog, the owner-
 - may, within 14 days of receiving notice of the classification, object in writing to the territorial authority in regard to the classification; and
 - (b) has the right to be heard in support of the objection.
- (2) The territorial authority considering an objection under subsection (1) may uphold or rescind the classification, and in making its determination must have regard to—
 - (a) the evidence which formed the basis for the classification; and
 - (b) any steps taken by the owner to prevent any threat to the safety of persons or animals; and
 - (c) the matters relied on in support of the objection; and
 - (d) any other relevant matters.
- (3) The territorial authority must, as soon as practicable, give written notice to the owner of-
 - (a) its determination of the objection; and
 - (b) the reasons for its determination.

I wish to object to the Menacing Dog Classification and would like this to be explained so I can understand what all this will mean for me but more so for Sarge.

- You had said you would provide a statement from the person that claims Sarge pinned down and attacked their dog while walking past.
- 2. Sarge has not been known to bite or hurt anyone, or any other animal.
- 3. There is no evidence of any vet bill to prove an attack has occured.
- 4. There is no evidence of him worrying sheep or any other animal.
- 5. Sarge is registered and well loved and cared for by our family

works at the Corrections Department next door to the Dog Pound in Pukekohe. She has weekly visits to our address

and has never had an issue with Sarge for the last 7 months and was quite surprised at hearing he is to be classed as menacing and will

provide me with a statement to confirm what she said.

I acknowledge that Sarge has been impounded for roaming. A kennel and large run is being erected at present for him. Also Sarge will be desexed, I don't think this is the problem. He is a high energy dog that loves to run and play but far from menacing. Without proof of this I do not understand nor do I think it can be determined solely by Animal Control to classify him as Menacing.

Failure to Comply with Menacing Classification

Background

- 1. On 28 November 2023, following an investigation into a dog attack Waikato District Council ("Council") issued a Notice of Classification of Dog as Menacing Dog in accordance with section 33A of the Dog Control Act 1996 (Act) in respect of your dog "Sarge". Your partner, objected to this notice within the 14-day period under the Act on your behalf. This objection will be heard by the Waikato District Council Hearings Committee. Not withstanding that an objection has been raised, the effects of the Menacing Classification will stay in force until an order to rescind the classification has been determined.
- 2. In accordance with section 33E(1)(a) of the Act you as the owner of "Sarge" must not allow the dog to be at large or in any public place or in any private right of way, without being muzzled.
- 3. You have failed to contain "Sarge" in accordance with section 33E(1)(a) of the Act and, as such you, as the registered owner, are non-compliant with "Sarge's" menacing dog classification (Menacing Classification).

Failure to comply with Menacing Classification

- 4. On the 29 January 2024 Waikato District Council received a complaint regarding "Sarge" leaving the property.
- 5. Sarge was video recorded chasing sheep at 6:40pm then sighted again wandering in a nearby paddock.

Next steps

6. Pursuant to section 33EC(b) of the Act Council is not going to release Sarge back into your custody until it is satisfied that you have demonstrated a willingness to comply with the Menacing Classification (section 33E(1) of the Act). The evidence to date suggests that what you are using to

contain your dogs is not adequate. Council is however prepared to give you a further seven (7) days from the date of this letter (until **5pm 7 February 2024**) to demonstrate comprehensively how you intend to contain Sarge on your property. A property Inspection would need to be carried out by an Animal Control officer to ensure that the fencing is adequate to contain the dog. The dog will not be able to go back to your property until you have an appropriate containment area which complies with the menacing classification and prevents your dog from been able to leave the property

- 7. If after seven days (by 5pm 7 February 2024), Council is satisfied that you have <u>not</u> demonstrated a willingness to comply with the effect of the Menacing Classification, Council will retain custody of "Sarge" and notify you in writing of its reasons for this decision and the implications of this decision (i.e. that Council will have the right to dispose of "Sarge", subject to the determination of any appeal to the District Court, in accordance with section 71A of the Act).
- 8. It is recommended that you obtain independent legal advice in relation to this letter and its contents.

- If a dog is classified as a menacing dog under section 33A or section 33C, the owner of the dog—
 - (a) must not allow the dog to be at large or in any public place or in any private way, except when confined completely within a vehicle or cage, without being muzzled in such a manner as to prevent the dog from biting but to allow it to breathe and drink without obstruction; and
 - (b) must, if required by the territorial authority, within 1 month after receipt of notice of the classification, produce to the territorial authority a certificate issued by a veterinarian certifying—
 - (i) that the dog is or has been neutered; or
 - that for reasons that are specified in the certificate, the dog will not be in a fit condition to be neutered before a date specified in the certificate; and
 - (c) must, if a certificate under paragraph (b)(ii) is produced to the territorial authority, produce to the territorial authority, within 1 month after the date specified in that certificate, a further certificate under paragraph (b)(i).

Failure to Comply with Menacing Classification

Background

- 1. On 28 November 2023, following an investigation into a dog attack Waikato District Council ("Council") issued a Notice of Classification of Dog as Menacing Dog in accordance with section 33A of the Dog Control Act 1996 (Act) in respect of your dog "Sarge". Your partner, objected to this notice within the 14-day period under the Act on your behalf. This objection will be heard by the Waikato District Council Hearings Committee. Not withstanding that an objection has been raised, the effects of the Menacing Classification will stay in force until an order to rescind the classification has been determined.
- 2. In accordance with section 33E(1)(a) of the Act you as the owner of "Sarge" must not allow the dog to be at large or in any public place or in any private right of way, without being muzzled.
- 3. You have failed to contain "Sarge" in accordance with section 33E(1)(a) of the Act and, as such you, as the registered owner, are non-compliant with "Sarge's" menacing dog classification (Menacing Classification).

Failure to comply with Menacing Classification

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- 5. Sarge was video recorded chasing sheep at 6:40pm then sighted again wandering in a nearby paddock.

contain your dogs is not adequate. Council is however prepared to give you a further seven (7) days from the date of this letter (until **5pm 7 February 2024**) to demonstrate comprehensively how you intend to contain Sarge on your property. A property Inspection would need to be carried out by an Animal Control officer to ensure that the fencing is adequate to contain the dog. The dog will not be able to go back to your property until you have an appropriate containment area which complies with the menacing classification and prevents your dog from been able to leave the property

- 7. If after seven days (by 5pm 7 February 2024), Council is satisfied that you have <u>not</u> demonstrated a willingness to comply with the effect of the Menacing Classification, Council will retain custody of "Sarge" and notify you in writing of its reasons for this decision and the implications of this decision (i.e. that Council will have the right to dispose of "Sarge", subject to the determination of any appeal to the District Court, in accordance with section 71A of the Act).
- 8. It is recommended that you obtain independent legal advice in relation to this letter and its contents.

33E Effect of classification as menacing dog

- (1) If a dog is classified as a menacing dog under section 33A or section 33C, the owner of the dog-
 - (a) must not allow the dog to be at large or in any public place or in any private way, except when confined completely within a vehicle or cage, without being muzzled in such a manner as to prevent the dog from biting but to allow it to breathe and drink without obstruction; and
