# 5. SH21 Underpass Update - Victoria Cooper (Downers)

- South side concrete stairwell panels, tyre well, pre cast walls in place
- North Side waiting on delivery of pre cast wall
- Work site closed 23<sup>rd</sup> Dec. to 5<sup>th</sup> January
- Estimated completion; end of February 2022

## 6. Tamahere School Pool and Targeted rates

- The school pool would operate at an approximate \$19,000 loss over the year, if opened to the public over summer.
- Most of the loss comes from costs associated with opening the pool to the public over the summer holidays and meeting health and safety requirements out of school time.
- More profitable to open to water polo and other learn to swim and training groups.
- School has tried various systems to keep the pool open to the public. All come with issues.
- Health and Safety a major concern with ultimate liability falling with the Principal.
- TCC concludes this situation does not be appropriate for a targeted rate.

## Dog Control Bylaw and Policy Consultation

- A choice between 2 new fenced dog exercise areas proposed for Tamahere- Te Awa Reserve and at Tamahere Park.

# Annebrook Road

Stage 2 – \_Turning Head and SH1

• Under construction, with civil works programmed to be completed in early December. The bridge balustrade is separate, to be completed in late December.

## **Tamahere Park Toilets**

- Final design details being worked through. Architect producing examples of various roof shapes, cladding and colour options for selection by community and stakeholders.
- Construction scheduled to start in early February following consultation with key stakeholders.

## Woodcock Road Footpath

- The road side is very busy with bikers and walkers.
- Need to undersand numbers using this route to support this.
- Look at reinstating a counter on Alan Turner Bridge.
- Requires NZTA match funding.

## Targeted Rates

- WDC -2 targeted rates levied on a per dweling basis;
  - \$70 for Tamahere Community Centre, \$38 for Tamahere Park
- Hall rate covers a loan with repayment date of June 2022. The rate collection continues unchanged after the loan repayment.
- Hall Committee keen to continue to retain the full amount to off set future repairs and maintenance.
- Additional groups interested in a portion of the hall rates after appropriate consultation.
- Additional group keen to persue an additional rate on top of those being collected.

• TCC asks for a maintenance budget from the Hall committee to understand ongoing costs.

### Local Area Speed Limits

Council is proposing that they reduce the speed limit to 60kph on Tamahere Drive between the country club and the SH1 interchange, and Tauwhare Road between Woodcock Road and the SH1 interchange as part of a district wide review of speed limits.
