2023 is the 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Raglan Surf Life Saving Club

To celebrate this milestone the club with be holding a lunch and lifesaving demonstration and a get together for past and present clubbies at the clubrooms on the 22<sup>nd</sup> October with a dinner at the Raglan Club in the evening.

To record the history of the club over the past 50 years and to ensure this history is not lost we have asked Elizabeth Amoore to write/compile the history of the club over the past 50 years. This has resulted in her sourcing past photos from clubbies all over the country and also interviewing several key members who have had a role in the club some since its inception.

The out come will be a comprehensive record of the ups and downs of the club since an inaugural club was formed in the 1960 but closed due to lack of membership and it was not until 1973 that the present club was formed.

The club is printing 150 books which will be sold to those attending the reunion but needs support to get the books printed and also sponsorship to cover any shortfall.

Copies will be donated to the Raglan Museum and also to Raglan Library for the public to read.

#### **Supporting Information**

Raglan Surf Life Saving is a volunteer organisation and while it does get some government funding around fifty percent of its annual costs come from sponsorship and private funders.
