	Issue	Area	Action
١.	Paint the internal side of the new door frame at the new hall.	Service Delivery	Facilities Maintenance Officer has been on site to assess work needed. He will need to return possibly three times to fill holes, and do multiple coats of paint.
2.	Want to know if Meremere can have on and off ramps on the expressway	Service Delivery/Gareth Bellamy	Any access to the State Highway (Expressway) is the responsibility of NZTA. They are unlikely to create any additional on/off ramps at Meremere. The contact details for NZTA are <u>Grant.Tregida@nzta.govt.nz</u>
3.	Query about the WDC Facebook post regarding Meremere being topped up with a water tank. Committee seeks clarification.	Communications	Watercare, on behalf of Waikato District Council, delivered 5 tankers of water on Monday 10 February and again on Monday 17 February. Each tanker carries around 16 cube (16,000L) of water. This was needed because demand was higher than what was coming into the reservoir. If we didn't top up the reservoir, and the request to conserve water had not gone out, there was a high risk of the township running out of water. The photo in the Facebook post was taken by a Watercare staff member standing on top of the reservoir.
4.	Query about grazing the land adjacent to the new library. There are cows but the fence is not in good order, cows keep getting out. Whose responsibility is this?	Service Delivery	Council staff are currently waiting for completion of a survey to define the legal boundary. When the survey is completed the Projects Team will be able to erect appropriate fencing on the legal boundary. Council staff have contacted the person who we believe is grazing the area and asked them to cease and desist until (1) the fences are mended and (2) they have a valid Licence to Occupy. If stock are breaking out and causing problems WDC Animal Control should be contacted directly on 0800 492 452.
5.	The camera from the new library has been stolen, can we have an update?	Service Delivery	Camera has been replaced. No further action required.
