




Bust Two myths And an additional fact

Honey bee numbers are declining
No they are Not !



Tripling of bee hive numbers <15 yrs



Year



Honey production Stats

Low end

 2 kg honey / Ha typical farm grassland

High end

 - 500 – 1500 kg honey produced from 500 trees (my 0.5Ha lifestyle block)

•15-30 kg per hive considered reasonable production

2. Honey bees not essential for life

- •Glass house – Tomatoes – Capsicums
- •Bumble bees !





Seedless often means no pollination

.Citrus – don't require pollination





Other insects also pollinate

"The studies spanned five continents and examined pollination of 17 different crops, including coffee, apples, mangoes, and radishes, as well as almonds and watermelons. The analysis showed that flies, beetles, butterflies, ants, and wasps were responsible for nearly 40 percent of the workload. That number varied by crop and location; in some places, that number reached 50 percent. In other places, non-bee bugs were the only pollinators."

Additional fact

.NZ has 28 species of native bees

- .There is overlap in feeding for some species
- •Excess honey bee numbers may impact NZ native species



The problem at Ohinewai

Approximately 150 hives on 3.3Ha

- -750 000 1 500 000 bees
- At the Rural Urban interface

Current system isn't working

Attempted to address problem ad hoc

Formally raised by Ohinewai resident October
2020

 Doesn't appear to have appeared to meet the standard for public nuisance

Recommendation

.Either new district wide by law

- Limit of 5 or 10 / Ha
- This still gives very high stocking ability for the average hobbyist or reasonable hive density for commercial operators

.Or extend the bee part of this policy to include all areas and include limit of 5 or 10 / Ha in rural zone.
