The programme is jam packed with tools and practical activities that can be taken straight back to your organisation or to help you start one.

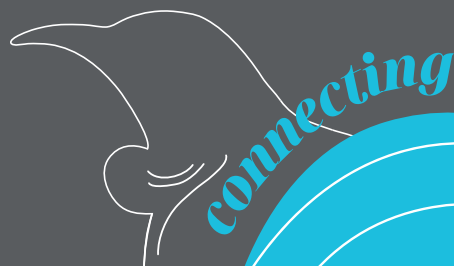


Do you put time and effort into making our communities a better place to live, work and play?

Find out what funders are looking for and how to finance your project with alternative income streams.

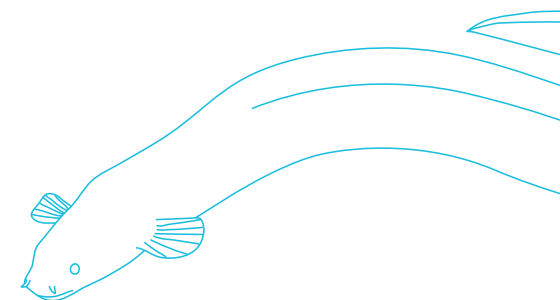
