Re: farm access tracks on Gleeson property in Huntly

The ponds on the Gleeson property were made by pushing fill across gullies to enable farm access tracks to be formed. The resulting ponds were used for stockwater and duck shooting. We used to own that particular block and it was farmed for sheep. The ponds were periodically dug out (hitachi UH04) and a bunch of redwoods were planted around one of the ponds. My Uncle used to shoot ducks there. My father, Uncle and Grandfather used these tracks to access the coal mine at the top of the hill, called the "Highland Mine" and worked there for Ernie Stokes.
