Application to request standard 20mm new water supply connection/s installed by Council; these will require a connection fee and/or a development contribution to be paid at the time of application. *All fees and charges associated with the connection (including development contributions) are to be paid within 20 working days from the invoice date otherwise, this application will lapse and be cancelled.*

If you are within a **Restricted supply** area per Waikato District Council Water Supply Bylaw 2014 (within 2021 amendments), this supply will require a flow restrictor to be put in place with the water meter. This will limit the daily intake to 1.8m³ at a steady flow rate through the water meter. Customers receiving a restricted flow supply shall make provision for on-site water storage of a minimum volume of 22,000L, or the equivalent of at least 48 hours of average water use where this is greater than 22,000L.

If Waikato District Council has approved your consent the installation and connection to water system will need to be completed privately by owner/agent and Council will not install these connections.

1. Council approved building consent
2. Qualified drain layer or a contractor with a NZ Certificate in Infrastructure Works Level 4 water strand for working on waters assets as per approved consent/engineering plans to complete installation.
3. Method and timeframe to complete works
4. Installation completed to meet Regional Infrastructure Technical Specifications

1. Water supply will not be connected by the Council until all relevant fees and charges have been paid. This includes connection fee and maybe development or capital works contribution charges.
2. This application is valid for 20 workings days from the confirmed written acceptance date by Council if unpaid after this time, Council will deem as lapsed and cancel.
3. The following ongoing charges will apply.
 - Fixed targeted rate
 - A charge per cubic metre used
4. The development contributions and ongoing charges for water supply are listed in the Council's Schedule of Fees and Charges and can be viewed on www.waikatodistrict.govt.nz or you may contact the Council for more information.
5. An approved backflow preventer will be required for all industrial or commercial uses, for residential properties connected to storage tanks, properties in the restricted supply area, properties with fire sprinkler systems, and swimming pools.
6. Acceptance of the water supply signifies acceptance of the Council's conditions of Water supply bylaw and regulations.
