The following on going charges will apply and are listed in the Councils schedule of fees and charges. These can be viewed on www.waikatodistrict.govt.nz or you may contact the Council for more information

1. Annual Fee
2. A charge per cubic metre used

- The approved standpipe must be used within Waikato District Council
- Designated water supply hydrants must be used as advised
- The standpipe must be blue colour
- Currently registered with the Ministry of Health as a water carrier
- A current test certificate for the two non-return valves installed, within 12 months
- A current registration sticker must be displayed at all times
- Use of incorrect standpipe will result in confiscation.
- Monthly notification for metered standpipes

Monthly readings for the meter on each standpipe need to be emailed to waters@waidc.govt.nz or as close to the first day of each month. Must be in the form of a clear photo showing the serial number and reading.

- Damage to water mains

In the event that the hydrant fails to operate correctly or will not shut off drip tight, please contact any Waikato District Council office immediately. The applicant will be held responsible for the cost of any repairs to the water supply network as a result of damage caused by incorrect use of the metered standpipe.

- Other damage

The applicant will be held responsible for any third-party damage that occurs whilst the metered standpipe is in use.

- Cancellation of permit

This permit may be revoked at any time if it is found that the holder does not abide by Council's regulations and bylaws controlling water supplies.

- Photo of the standpipe and meter number
- Confirmation of registration from Ministry of Health, if applicable
