Temporary Road Closure for motorsport events





This brochure is designed to assist you with planning and running a motorsport event within the District.

The Road Closure for Motor Sports Events policy outlines the requirements for Waikato District Council



Motor Sport Policy

An application to hold a motorsport event must be submitted to and approved by council at least 12 weeks before the event is to be held.

Prior to us advertising the proposed road closure, the applicant will give written notification to the adjoining residents, property owners and other affected parties of the proposed road closure. This will allow them the opportunity to make a submission on the proposed road closure.

Special considerations to be taken into account when applying for a motor sport event.

In assessing applications for closures of roads, the council will consider the following:

- The potential impact on the roading network in the vicinity of the proposed closure, the affect on any proposed roading capital and maintenance works and the risk to council of damage occurring to the road(s)
- The availability of alternative routes for motorists and the potential impact on adjoining landowners
- Time frames around local farming activities for example: lambing, calving, and duck shooting
- The frequency of use of any road(s) used for car rallies or hill climbs and/or
 access to the car rallies or hill climb, will generally not be allowed to exceed one
 per calendar year on unsealed roads and two per calendar year on sealed roads.
- Road closures on unsealed roads will only be permitted within the period of I
 October to 30 June of each year, except for significant rallies where an exception
 has been sought and approved by the Roading & Transportation Committee.
