# **ANNUAL PLAN 2017/18:** PROJECTS IN YOUR AREA



## WE MAINTAIN THE **ASSETS THAT SUSTAIN OUR COMMUNITIES**

Every three years we consult with you to produce a Long Term Plan that sets out the projects, activities, and services that will be invested in and developed by Council over the following 10 years. The Annual Plan is Council's budget for one financial year, explaining how the Council will fund projects, activities and services identified for that year. The Annual Plan 2017/18 represents year three of the 2015-25 Long Term Plan.

We are planning to do more work on our wastewater systems than we committed to when we prepared our Long Term Plan because we want to meet your expectations - as we understand them to be - for protecting our environment from wastewater spills. This means we are consulting with nearly 11,000 of our 33,000 district ratepayers, ie. those who benefit from reticulated wastewater services and who pay a targeted rate for these services. If you have a septic tank, and do NOT pay a wastewater rate, this change does not affect you.

We are not consulting with ratepayers on any other parts of our Annual Plan since there are no other significant changes to the work programmes we agreed with you in our 2015-25 Long Term Plan. However we'll still be out talking to you about the other work we're doing - and engaging with you about projects in your area as we start them.

#### **KEY WHANGAMARINO PROJECTS FOR 2017/18**

This map indicates some of the key projects that will be happening in your area in 2017/18.

#### These include:

- 3.865 km of road rehabilitation
- 13.457 km of road re-seal
- Te Kauwhata walkways growth driven and in line with Councils' Trails Strategy 2016
- Amo Street stormwater upgrade
- Design an upgrade for the water treatment plant

#### Wastewater:

- Apply for resource consent renewal for Meremere.
  If required, upgrade the wastewater treatment plant to comply with resource consent conditions
- Jetting to clean 10% of the Te Kauwhata network with CCTV inspection to obtain information about our network assets
