The Proceedings

4 Lochiel is interested in part of the proceedings. In particular, amendments sought by DOC in respect of Significant Natural Areas (**SNAs**).

Particular Issues

- 5 Lochiel is interested in the following particular issues:
 - (a) SNAs being mapped and the definition of SNAs; and
 - (b) Amendments to APP2.

Relief sought

6 Lochiel opposes the relief sought:

(a) The SNA areas have been mapped both with expert input; site visits;

using desktop tools; and following feedback with landowners about the appropriateness of some mapping. Lochiel is satisfied that the

SNA mapping on its land is appropriate.

(b) Having the areas mapped aligns with the proposed draft National

Policy Statement on Indigenous Biodiversity.

(c) Commercial forestry planting should not be considered as an SNA

as it is temporary and contradicts managing SNAs, in particular,

avoiding physical fragmentation is not possible. There are

provisions that limit the clearance of vegetation outside an SNA for

indigenous biodiversity.

resolution of the proceedings.
