It is clear that additional provision of phones, internet, water, power supply, sewage, roads, the area needed for shops, schools, etc. will be required, but it is hard to know whether the area set aside locally is reasonable, or what environmental problems the additional demand might create. To mitigate against the effects of climate change Homestar rated buildings, rain gardens and lots pf plants are needed.
