MAY IT PLEASE THE COMMISSIONERS:

- Counsel acts for NZTE Operations Limited (NZTE) on the Proposed Waikato District Plan (pWDP).
- NZTE seeks the Panel's leave to file Mr Serjeant's brief supplementary planning statement (incl. annexed updated planning provisions), dated 29 April 2021.
