INTRODUCTION

- 1. Hearing 18 Rural is scheduled to commence on Tuesday 29 September 2020.
- 2. Submitters have previously been advised that this hearing would be held in the Waikato District Council Chamber at Ngaruawahia.
- 3. The decision to hold the hearing in the Council Chamber was made prior to the recent changes to Covid 19 alert levels, which amongst other things, means that the size of "public gatherings" is restricted, especially as they relate to Auckland and Aucklanders when they travel to other areas.
- 4. It remains unclear when the current restrictions will be relaxed and what they will contain. There is also a lingering concern for some about attending public gatherings, irrespective of their size and the safety measures put in place.
- 5. In order to:
 - a. Provide certainty to all submitters, their counsel and consultants, Council staff and their consultants, and the Panel; and
 - b. Be satisfied that all participants are not exposed to risks that they may not feel comfortable about,

the Panel has decided that Hearing 20 - Rural will commence, as planned, on 29 September 2020, **but will occur via Zoom**.
