## Variation I to the Proposed Waikato District Plan (Stage I) Te Kowhai Airport Obstacle Limitation Surface

Waikato District Council has prepared the following variation to the proposed Waikato District Plan (Stage I) to fix an error that has been identified on the maps relating to the Te Kowhai Airport Obstacle Limitation Surface. Council also proposes some minor changes to the text in Appendix 9 that describes the Te Kowhai Airport Obstacle Limitation Surface to make it clearer.

## Submissions

## Have your say by 5pm on Friday 31 July 2020

The process for public participation in the consideration of Variation I is as follows:

- After the closing date for submissions, the Council must prepare a summary of the submissions and this summary must be publicly notified;
- There must be an opportunity to make a further submission in support of, or in opposition to, the submissions already made;
- If a person making a submission asks to be heard in support of his or her submission, a hearing must be held;
- Waikato District Council must give its decisions on the proposal (including its reasons for accepting or rejecting submissions);
- Any person who has made a submission has the right to appeal the decision on the proposal to the Environment Court.
