As of 30 June 2025, there were 54 On-Licences, 51 Off-Licences and 46 Clubs holding a licence within the Waikato licensing district.

Comments on any changes or trends in the Committee's workload in 2024-2025

Committee Member Response:

Cross Examination: The removal of cross-examination of agencies, witnesses and objectors by the applicant has increased pre-hearing and hearing workload of the committee members. Previously the parties, counsel or consultants have asked most of the questions. Now, the questioning falls to the committee members to prepare and ask the questions. Counsel and consultants have a reduced role during a hearing. The removal of cross-examination has opened the door to a more inquisitorial approach by the committee.

Case Law Developments: As case law develops, the Committee members searching and reading workload has increased. For example the development of extended suitability 'elements' and its application in a licensing district with areas of high deprivation. Workload is impacted by easier access to legal databases or not.

Agency Reports: The depth and breadth of the tri-agency reports can assist the Committee with its workload. At times, one or more of the agencies has not reported and or reported about vulnerability/extended suitability when this has been raised by the objector or Police have not reported about alcoholrelated policing matters.







New Initiatives the Committee has developed/adopted in 2024/2025

Committee Members Response:

- Karakia at the start of the hearing and the end of the day
- Inviting local kaumatua to say karakia
- Asking people not to stand when the DLC enters and leaves a room
- witnesses not standing when giving evidence
- less emphasis on formal attire by DLC members
- enabling seating arrangements that accommodate people's needs, e.g. community objectors sit together
- at times hearing from witnesses in a different order from usual

Has your Territorial Authority developed a Local Alcohol Policy?

Yes, at 30 June 2025, the Local Alcohol Policy had been adopted.

Please comment on the ways in which you believe the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 is, or is not, achieving its objective. Note: the objective of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 is that:A) The sale, supply, and consumption of alcohol should be undertaken safely and responsibly; andB) The harm caused by the excessive or inappropriate consumption of alcohol should be minimised.

Commissioner Response:

Generally, believe that the Act is achieving its purpose.

Committees Members Response:

In 2024-25, the provisions regarding LAPs and the appeal process, meant the WDC did not have a LAP (had a P-LAP)

that reflected more recent voices of the community members. This allowed a gap for applicants to seek off-licences in communities that endorsed harm minimisation and licence limits.

The tikanga provisions have fostered reduced formality and greater level of objector comfort in making submissions about the alcohol related harm in their communities.

The ability for witnesses and objectors to appear online is a strength and assist with achieving the objective

What changes or trends in licensing have you seen since the Act came into force?

Committee Member Response:

ARLA decisions seem to be lacking consistency or are silent on emerging issues ARLA to provide declaratory judgments or practise notice guidance on issues such as, minimum price point etc

Seeing a lot of tick box compliance from the licence holder, rather than true engagement in safe supply of alcohol. They submit generic materials but have no ownership of the material, especially around communication with the community.

Licensing Inspector Comment:

Since the Community Participate Amendment (CPA) Act came in to force the number of co-ordinated objections appears to have increased with some objections unfortunately lacking the depth of evidence necessary to provide weight to the objection.

What changes to practices and procedures under the Act (if any) would you find beneficial?

Commissioner Response: The fees schedule in the Act has not changed since its inception. Councils are far from full cost recovery in terms of licensing. It would be good to address this centrally, rather than relying on individual councils to pass bylaws to change the licensing fees.

Falling far short of full cost recovery puts pressure on councils and creates unhelpful time and workload pressure on licensing inspectors.

On a related note, the rates paid to committee members and chairs/commissioners have also not changed since

the Act was brought in. If we want to attract high-quality committee members, DLCs must be able to offer competitive remuneration as

recognition of the time commitment expected. The longer that rates remain the same, the greater this problem is going to get.

Committee Member Response: The development of a procedures document that also address s203 A.

That tikanga is part of all aspects of DLC licensing processes.

Training - Tri-agencies are well versed in extended suitability and include their inquiries on this matter in their reports.

Access to a caselaw data base.

Sensitive sites need to reflect local tikanga.
