



Stormwater upgrades update

We have been working on the detailed plans for upcoming work to improve stormwater resilience and reduce urban flood risk around Port Waikato.

From an initial longer list, the following projects are being investigated in detail.

Pump station upgrade

- To increase resilience and capacity, key to network efficiency

Ooraeroa Marae

- Improving draining to reduce flood risks

Landslide above Wharf Store

- Work to reduce future landslide risk from neighbouring farmland

Port Waikato Holiday Park

- Work to reduce urban flood risk

Main drain

- Investigations show that widening the main drain will be less beneficial than initial research showed. We will be providing an update on this at the stormwater meeting.

These upgrades are linked to the government-awarded Stormwater Resilience Fund, which has provided us with \$2.35m to invest in stormwater improvements in the town.
