

IN THE MATTER of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

AND

IN THE MATTER of an application by Trek for Life Aotearoa / NZ Charitable Trust pursuant to s.138 of the Act for a special licence in respect of premises situated at 74 Lee Road TUAKAU known as “Trek for Life Aotearoa/NZ Trust”.

DECISION

[1] I have before me an application by Trek for Life Aotearoa / NZ Charitable Trust for a special licence in respect of premises situated at 74 Lee Road TUAKAU.

[2] The inspector has filed a report on the application and does not oppose the granting of the special licence. The Police and the Medical Officer of Health have offered no opposition to the granting of the special licence. I thank the reporting agencies for their prompt responses.

[3] The application is for a charitable event that is part of a week long series of similar events at various addresses in the Waikato area.

[4] For the purpose of this licence the licensed area (premises) is as defined within the site plan submitted with the application.

[5] The following conditions will apply to the licence:

- (a) Alcohol may be sold under the licence only on the following days and during the following hours:
Saturday, 4 March 2023 from 2.00pm to 12.00midnight
- (b) The licensee must take the following steps to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
 - (i) Display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.
- (c) The licensee must take the following steps to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the management of the premises are observed:
 - (i) All staff will be trained in their responsibilities under the Act.
 - (ii) A sign shall be prominently displayed inside the premises, which identifies by name the manager on duty for the management of the sale and supply of alcohol under the licence.

- (d) Drinking water must be freely available at the the bar and from the water station set up outside the Marquee.
- (e) The licensee shall have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when alcohol may be sold and supplied under the licence, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic refreshments and low alcoholic beverages.
- (f) A reasonable range of food appropriate to the event shall be available during the hours of this licence.
- (g) No BYO alcoholic beverages are permitted within the premises.
- (h) The licensee must provide assistance with or information about alternative forms of transport from the premises.
- (i) A minimum of one certificate holding manager is required to be on site and on duty to manage the conduct of the sale and supply of alcohol during the hours of this licence.
- (j) The whole of the premises is undesignated.

[6] I am satisfied as to the matters to which I must have regard in s.142 of the Act, and I am satisfied that this application meets the purpose and object of the Act. Accordingly, I grant the special licence which may issue immediately.

[7] A copy of the licence is to be publicly displayed at the bar.
