DECISION

[1] I have before me an application by Barrelled Wines Raglan Limited for an off licence in respect of premises situated at 1638 Whaanga Road RUAPUKE known as “Barrelled Wines”.

[2] The general nature of the business to be undertaken for the premises is that of a winery cellar door.

[3] The premise is as defined within the site plan submitted with the application and most recently date stamped received by the Waikato District Licensing Committee on 14 October 2022.

[4] Reports on the application were received from an Inspector, the Medical Officer of Health and the Police and offer no opposition.

[5] The application was duly advertised and did not attract any public objection.

[6] I am satisfied as to all matters which I must have regard as set out in s.105 of the Act, and I am satisfied that the application meets the purpose and object of the Act. Accordingly, I grant the applicant an off licence with the following conditions:

- (a) No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Christmas Day, or before 1.00 pm on Anzac Day.
- (b) No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Easter Sunday unless the alcohol is grape wine or fruit wine, or vegetable wine made-
 - (i) on the premises; or
 - (ii) from grapes or fruit harvested from land on which the premises are situated.
- (c) Only alcohol which is grape wine or fruit, or vegetable wine made on the premises or from produce harvested from land on which the premises are situated may be sold on the premises, and only during the following days and hours:

Monday to Sunday

7.00am to 7.00pm

- (d) Drinking water must be freely available to customers while alcohol is being supplied free as a sample on the premises.
- (e) The licensee must take the following steps to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
 - (i) Display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.
- (f) The licensee must take the following steps to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the management of the premises are observed:
 - (i) All staff will be trained in their responsibilities under the Act.
 - (ii) A sign shall be prominently displayed inside the premises, which identifies by name the manager on duty or of the person responsible for the management of the sale and supply of alcohol under the licence.
- (g) The sale or delivery of alcohol is authorised on the premises generally. The premises situated at 1638 Whaanga Road, Raglan are more precisely identified in a plan date stamped as received by the Waikato District Licensing Committee on the 3 March 2023.

[7] The licence may issue upon payment of any outstanding fee.

[8] I refer any party who wishes to appeal this decision or part of this decision to sections 154 through to 158 of the Act.
