DECISION

[1] I have before me an application by Lions Club of Te Kauwhata and Districts Incorporated for a special licence in respect of premises situated at 40 Mahi Road, Te Kauwhata known as "Lions / RSA Hall".

[2] The inspector has filed a report on the application and does not oppose the granting of the special licence. The Police and the Medical Officer of Health have offered no opposition to the granting of the special licence.

[3] The application is for a series of club dinner events.

[4] For the purpose of this licence the licensed area (premises) is as defined within the site plan submitted with the application.

[5] The following conditions will apply to the licence:

- a) Alcohol may be sold under the licence only on the following days and during the following hours:

**Thursday, 5 February 2026 from 6.00pm to 9.00pm,
Thursday, 5 March 2026 from 6.00pm to 9.00pm,
Thursday, 2 April 2026 from 6.00pm to 9.00pm,
Thursday, 7 May 2026 from 6.00pm to 9.00pm,
Thursday, 4 June 2026 from 6.00pm to 9.00pm,
Thursday, 2 July 2026 from 6.00pm to 9.00pm,
Thursday, 6 August 2026 from 6.00pm to 9.00pm,
Thursday, 3 September 2026 from 6.00pm to 9.00pm,
Thursday, 1 October 2026 from 6.00pm to 9.00pm,
Thursday, 5 November 2026 from 6.00pm to 9.00pm and
Thursday, 3 December 2026 from 6.00pm to 9.00pm.**

- b) Food in the form of a two-course dinner shall be served.

- c) The licensee shall have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when alcohol may be sold and supplied under the licence, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic refreshments and low alcoholic beverages.
- d) Drinking water is to be freely available to attendees at the bar and on all occupied tables.
- e) The following steps must be taken to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
 - i. Ensure that no intoxicated persons are allowed to enter or to remain on the premises.
 - ii. Ensure that appropriate signs are prominently displayed detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of liquor to minors and intoxicated persons adjacent to every point of sale.
 - iii. Ensure that appropriate signs are prominently displayed detailing information about alternative forms of transport from the premises
- f) A certificate holding manager is required to be on site and on duty to manage the conduct of the sale and supply of alcohol during the hours of this licence.
- g) The whole of the premises is undesignated.

[6] I am satisfied as to the matters to which I must have regard in s.142 of the Act, and I am satisfied that this application meets the purpose and object of the Act. Accordingly, I grant the special licence which may issue immediately.

[7] A copy of the licence is to be publicly displayed at the bar.
