DECISION

[1] I have before me an application by Beard Trading Limited for a temporary authority in respect of premises situated at 4 Main Road, Te Kauwhata known as “New World Te Kauwhata”.

[2] The application for the temporary authority was filed with the Waikato District Council on 4th June 2026 and is the first such application made by this applicant. The inspector reports that the applicant has requested it take effect from 13th July 2026.

[3] The applicant has sought this temporary authority on the grounds that they have purchased the business and wish to continue to trade within the conditions of the underlying licence for the premises whilst they work towards lodging an application for a substantive licence. I note the underlying off licence is to expire on 21 July 2026.

[4] The inspector has filed a report on the application and does not oppose the granting of the temporary authority. The Police have not opposed the application.

[5] I am satisfied as to the matters to which I must have regard, and I am satisfied that the application meets the Purpose and Object of the Act, accordingly, I grant the temporary authority.

[6] This temporary authority authorises the applicant to carry on the sale and supply of alcohol with the same conditions contained within the underlying licence number 14/OFF/13/2023.

[7] The temporary authority is issued for the period not exceeding three months and may issue to take effect from 13th July 2026.

[8] A copy of this temporary authority is to be displayed alongside a copy of the underlying licence within the premises.
